Graham "Botia" Forrest Knight, 80, of Salisbury, NC passed away Friday, July 31, 2020 at Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center.

He was born August 29, 1939 in Orange County, NC to the late John Walter Knight and Mary Hargis Knight. Mr. Knight was retired from Cone Mill where he was a Master Mechanic for 35 years and was head sheet metal fabricator of M&M Heating and Air. Currently he was the owner of Knight Custom Construction, LLC and built numerous homes over the past 25 years.
