



## Mr. Jack Edward Neubacher

February 23, 1946 - October 7, 2018

Jack Edward Neubacher, 72, of Salisbury, passed away Sunday, October 7, 2018 at his home.

Born February 23, 1946 in Geneva, OH, he was the son of the late Gladys Ruth Anderson Neubacher and Emil August Neubacher.

He was educated in the Geneva, OH schools and graduated from Geneva High School. Mr. Neubacher was a veteran of the US Navy and served in the Vietnam War.

Mr. Neubacher was a machinist for Lane Punch Corp. for 40 years before retiring. Prior to that he was a meat cutter for the family grocery store, Anderson Food Market in Geneva, OH.

He was of the Methodist faith. Mr. Neubacher has been a private pilot since the age of 16 and owned a 1956 Piper Tri Pacer airplane. He was a charter member and served as President of the Experimental Aircraft Association, Chapter 1083 based at the Rowan County Airport, was a member of the NC Quarter Midget Association where he dearly loved racing with his grandson and family, and wrote articles for the Southern Aviator Magazine.

Those left to cherish his memory are his wife of 48 years, Dianne Ricketts Neubacher; son, Marcus Neubacher of China Grove; daughter, Jennifer Neubacher Rogers of Salisbury; grandson, Benjamin Rogers of Salisbury; brother, Robert "Bob" Neubacher and wife Lenore of Duncan, SC.

The family will receive friends from 7-9 PM Thursday at the Summersett Funeral Home and at other times the family will be at the residence.

A graveside service will be conducted 11 AM – Friday (Oct. 12) at the Salisbury VA National Cemetery with the Rev. Michael Rakes, minister of Cornerstone Baptist Church

officiating. Military Graveside Rites will be conducted by the US Navy and the Rowan County Veterans Honor Guard.
