Mr. Alan DeLynn Moore passed away on Sunday, August 09, 2015 at Kiser Hospice House in Salisbury, NC. He was 79 years old.

Born in Delco, NC, Alan was raised in Carolina Beach, NC. He attended Carolina Beach Grammar School and was a graduate of New Hanover High School in Wilmington, NC. He attended the University of North Carolina in Chapel Hill and the University of Maryland. He was a career United States Air Force (USAF) Non-Commissioned Officer, retiring from active duty in 1974. After serving in the USAF, he began a second profession and for 25 years worked as an Orthodontic Technician for Dr. W. Smith Kirk and Dr. R. Byron Moore in Salisbury.

Alan was a 32nd degree Mason and member of the Muenster Lodge, located in Ulm, Germany. He was a warm, caring and private individual who was devoted to his family and friends.
