



Mr Albert Curtis Brown Jr.

January 30, 1935 - September 20, 2014

Albert Curtis Brown, Jr., age 79, currently of Salisbury passed peacefully to our Lord at 8:02AM on September 20, 2014 at North Carolina State Veterans Home in Salisbury.

He was born January 30, 1935 in Concord, the son of the late Albert Curtis Brown, Sr. and Charlie-Belle McRae. He was a 1957 graduate of Catawba College with a Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration. Later, he was Public Relations Director for the college.

Albert was a 33rd degree Mason and served as Past Master of the Numa F. Reid Lodge twice and was awarded the Knight York Cross of Honor as well as a Knight of Malta. Al served in the United States Army with the 991st Transportation Company in Salisbury for 6 years reaching the rank of Staff Sergeant with a temporary commission as a US Army Officer. Al received several Accolades including Outstanding Soldier for North Carolina during the Cuban Missile Crisis. He was a leader in the banking, woodworking machinery and tooling industry. He was a manager for Mattison-Greenlee Service Corp., and National Sales Manager for Forest City Tools. He was a caring and loving man with a cheerful personality that everyone adored.

Al had a lot of loves in his life but none more than his family; especially his wife Joyce Chapman Brown. He is survived by his wife whom he married June 14, 1958; three daughters Cindy Amerson, Elizabeth Laxton and Jeannie Farrell; sister Kay Ervin; brother Larry Brown; seven grandchildren and three great grandchildren. He will be loved forever and greatly missed.

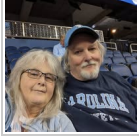
