Amelia Brier Trundle, 85, of Salisbury, passed away Saturday, September 22, 2018 at her residence surrounded by her loving family.

Born December 9, 1932 to the late William F. Brown and the late Clarabelle Swaim Brown of Lexington, NC, she was a graduate of Lexington Sr. High School and furthered her education at Hollins College. Amelia was presented at the North Carolina Debutant Ball in Raleigh. In her youth, Amelia enjoyed riding show horses, and was a NC state champion during her high school years.
