



Mr. Andrew Sabol Jr.

May 25, 1922 - August 26, 2016

Andrew “Andy” Sabol, Jr, 94, a resident at the State Veterans Home in Salisbury, NC passed away August 26, 2016.

Andy was Born May 25, 1922 in Mingo Junction, OH to the late Andrew Sabol, Sr. and Anna Sabol.

Andy was raised in Follansbee, WV and graduated from Follansbee High School in 1940. Following graduation, he served for a year in the Civilian Conservation Corp in Ohio. Andy was inducted into the US Army in 1942 and served in the 13th Air Force of the Army Air Corp through several campaigns in the south Pacific until his discharge after the end of the War.

He migrated to Connecticut where he began his career in manufacturing and served as a foreman of Olivetti Underwood in Connecticut and Veeder-Root in North Carolina for close to forty years.

In Connecticut, he met and married in June 1947 his late long-time love, Vickie, with whom he enjoyed 57 years of happiness. Andy and Vickie moved to Surfside Beach, SC after Andy’s retirement where they enjoyed life until Vickie’s passing.

Andy served as Post Commander for the Veterans of Foreign War and was a

member of the Rotary Club during his time in Elizabethtown, NC. In addition to pulling for the Tar Heels, Andy enjoyed bowling and working in the yard and was always willing to help his friends and neighbors.

He was predeceased by his dear three sisters, Anna Meno, Sue Gerrek and Helen Moore.

Andy is survived by his son, Andrew; daughter-in-law, Kimberley; granddaughter, Kathryn; nieces, Millie Lewis, and Tillie Meno; nephews, John Meno, John Gerrek, and Michael Gerrek; and grand-nieces, grand-nephews and cousins.

Interment will be at St. Andrew Orthodox Church in Mingo Junction, OH at a future date.
