Andrew Thomas "Tommy" Head, Jr., 62, of Salisbury, NC passed away Tuesday, January 16, 2013.

Born August 22, 1950 in Salisbury, NC he was the son of Hazel Marie Sofley and the late Andrew Thomas Head.

Mr. Head was a graduate of East Rowan High School, class of 1968. He attended Appalachian State University and Davidson Community College, and graduated from University of North Carolina at Charlotte in 1974. Mr. Head worked at Food Lion as the Certified Energy Manager for 26 years. He also performed demolition work with his family in New Orleans for several years.

Mr. Head was a member of Bethel United Methodist Church where he sang in the choir, was the Head of Trustees, was on the finance committee, and helped with general repairs. He always gave freely of his time and talents, helping anyone that needed a hand.
