Mrs. Angelina “Angie” Semerano Mooney, 78, went to the Lord on Tuesday, December 13, 2011 at Kate B. Reynolds Hospice House in Winston Salem, NC.

Born November 20, 1933 in Middletown, NY, she was the last child born to Elizabeth Oliva and Leonardo Semerano. She moved to Salisbury with her first husband Edward A. Hirst in 1958. Mrs. Mooney was a loving mother, loved her children, made her own clothes, liked to work in the garden with vegetables and flowers and play bridge, and make her own clothes.
