Ann "Butter" Atwell Morris, 82, of Salisbury, NC passed away Sunday, August 5, 2018 at Novant Health Rowan Regional Medical Center.

She was born March 19, 1936 to the late Thomas C. Atwell and Idell Cress. She was a proud graduate of Boyden High School Class of 1954. Mrs. Morris worked for F.W. Woolworths then went to work for A&P Grocery, when that closed she worked for the Dr's Building Drug, then retired from Statewide Title.

Mrs. Morris was a member of First United Methodist Church and the Hedrick Friendship Class and at one time taught children's Sunday school. She was also a member of the Women of the Moose Chapter 1197 of Spencer where she served as Senior Regent. She was a member of several senior groups and often gave bell programs and skits for groups.
