Ann Honeycutt Godfrey, 64, of China Grove, NC died October 3, 2010 at CMC Northeast.

Mrs. Godfrey graduated from South Rowan High School. She attended Gupton Jones College in Atlanta, GA and received a degree in Funeral Directing and Embalming. She was the first licensed female Embalmer and Funeral Director in NC. She worked for her father at Linn-Honeycutt Funeral Home in China Grove for a number of years. From there she went to work for Rowan Emergency Medical Services, a job she truly loved. She retired as a Paramedic.
