Ann Shirley Jancic, 88, (formerly of Granite Quarry, NC) passed away Saturday, October 8th, after a period of declining health.

Born August 31, 1934 at home in Dravosburg, PA, she was the daughter of the late John and Helen (Palcsey) Burkley.
