



## Mrs. Anne Sheets Ramsey

July 28, 1919 - July 14, 2016

Anne Sheets Ramsey, long-time resident of Salisbury, passed away on July 14th in Plano, Texas .

Anne was born July 28, 1919, in Advance, North Carolina to Casper Lee Sheets and Sally Belle Sheets. The Sheets family moved from Advance to Ringgold, Virginia when Anne was a young child. She met and married Frank P. Ramsey, Sr. in 1940 at Danville, Virginia, and they moved to Salisbury, North Carolina.

In the 1950's Mrs. Ramsey established the Welcome Wagon Service in Salisbury and later a Welcome Wagon Newcomers Club for women. She was a charter member and past president of the Salisbury Pilot Club and was a long-time active member of the First Baptist Church of Salisbury where she was active in her Sunday School Class and the Silver and Gold Church Group. She also enjoyed being a volunteer in the gift shop at Rowan Regional Hospital. Anne was an avid bridge player and enjoyed membership in several bridge clubs. In later years traveling the US with Pilot Club groups and visiting family in Europe.

Mrs. Ramsey was predeceased by her husband Frank P. Ramsey, Sr. who was a life-long employee of the Southern Railway System, as was his father, J. Frank Ramsey. She was also preceded in death by seven brothers and sisters and is survived by one sister, Helen Martin of Danville, Va. Also survived by son Frank P. Ramsey, Jr. and his wife Janis of McKinney, TX, daughter Marie Koelling and her husband Gerald of Hillsborough N.C., four
