Arnold Dan "A. D." Powell, Sr., 61 of Salisbury died Friday, April 16, 2010 at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Born August 25, 1948 in Cabarrus County, he was the son of Ruby Jones Powell of Salisbury and the late J. D. Powell. He was educated in the Faith schools and graduated from East Rowan High School, Class of 1966.

Mr. Powell was President and part owner of Summit Salcoa Construction Company, LLC.

He was a member of Shiloh Reformed Church of Faith, served on the Board of Trustees of the Nazareth Children's Home, served on the Town Board of Granite Quarry, was a member of the Keller Memorial Masonic Lodge #657 A.F. & A. M., the Oasis Temple of the Shrine, and the Tac Twisters Car Club.
