



Bahnson "David" Hall MD

April 14, 1948 - May 13, 2022

Bahnson "David" Hall, MD passed away May 13, 2022 at Forsyth Medical Center, Winston Salem, NC from injuries suffered in a fall.

Born April 14, 1948 to the late Bahnson D. and Elsie Winters Hall in Winston Salem, David grew up in Burlington, NC. A graduate of Williams High School, Wake Forest University and Bowman Gray School of Medicine, he completed his residency in OB-Gyn at Portsmouth Naval Medical Center, Portsmouth, VA and served at Camp Lejeune Medical Center.

David and his family moved to Salisbury in 1980 where he joined Salisbury Clinic for Women (now Carolina Women's Health) and spent the next 30 years taking care of women and bringing new life into the world. A devoted doctor, husband, father and Papa/Grampa, David was a gentle man who served all with grace and devotion.

David was a member of First Presbyterian Church where he served as an Elder. He served on the Boards of both Rowan Helping Ministries and Ruffy-Holmes Senior Center and was a former member of the Salisbury Rotary Club. He served as an assistant Scoutmaster for Troop 448.

Preceding him in death is nephew, Edward Blake Tolley.

Left to cherish his memory is his wife of 51 years, Charlotte H. Hall; sons, Brian David Hall and wife Jennifer and their daughter, Savannah and Jason Robert Hall and Felipa and their son, Jason Miguel; sister-in-law, Rita H. Tolley; and niece, Elizabeth Gray Tolley.

A Memorial Service will be held at 11 AM Wednesday (May 18) at First

Presbyterian Church, officiated by Rev. Josh Musser-Gritter, Rev. Lara Musser-Gritter, and Dr. Randy Kirby. A reception will follow the service in Lewis Hall.

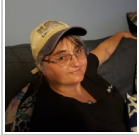
