



Barbara Taylor Ayers

April 20, 1938 - September 17, 2018

Barbara Taylor Ayers, age 80, of Salisbury died peacefully on September 17, 2018 at Rowan Memorial Hospital.

The daughter of the late Aaron Eugene Taylor and Ruby L. Peacock, she was born in Nash County on April 20, 1938. She attended Rocky Mount City schools and Peace College where she earned a business degree. Mrs. Ayers volunteered and was employed by the Salisbury/Rowan City school system and had been a member of the Salisbury/Rowan symphony guild.

She was a member of the First Baptist Church where she had served as a Sunday school teacher, led a missions group, served on the teller committee, taught vacation bible school, and served on various other committees. She was a member of the Summa Petenda Sunday school class. She also served on various committees with the parent/teacher association.

She is survived by her daughter, Caroline Ayers Parmiter and her husband, Ronald Scott Parmiter (Scott), and her two grandchildren, Megan Ayers Parmiter and Thomas Scott Parmiter.

In addition to her parents, preceding her in death was her husband, Tom Wherry Ayers and sister, Deborah Taylor Pridgen.

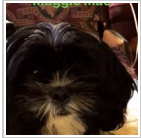
