Barry Foutz Isenhour, 60, of Salisbury, NC passed away Tuesday, April 28, 2020 at St. Mary's Hospital in Richmond, VA. after a brief illness.

He was born January 13, 1960 in Iredell County, NC to the late Charles Wesley Isenhour, Jr. and Mary Elizabeth Foutz Isenhour. Mr. Isenhour was a graduate of Fishburne Military Academy and Hocking Technical College of Ohio.

Barry worked for Horton Vineyards of Virginia in sales. He was an active member of the Virginia Flaggers, the Mechanized Calvary, SCV, the Rowan Rifles and other Southern Heritage Associations in NC and VA.

Surviving is his brother, Charles T. Isenhour of Salisbury, NC and sister Patricia Gaye Isenhour Vasilevich, Banner Elk, NC.
