Benny Dale Myers, 74, of Salisbury, NC passed away Tuesday, September 3, 2019 at the Novant Health Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House.

He was born December 11, 1944 in Rowan County, NC to the late Tiny Mae Brown Myers and Robert Glenn Myers. He attended Rowan County Schools and was a graduate of West Rowan High School, then attended Rowan Cabarrus Community College.

Mr. Myers owned and operated Myers Septic Tank Company, Inc. for 50 years.

He was a former member of the First Baptist Church of Spencer where he served as a Trustee, on the Finance Committee, and as Sunday School Treasurer. He was a member of the Hornets Nest Region of the Antique Automobile Club of American and was an avid car collector.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his brothers, Glenn Myers, James Myers, Wayne Myers.
