Mrs. Beth Blowers Wraight, 99, of Salisbury, NC passed away Tuesday, February 6, 2018 at her residence.

Mrs. Wraight was born October 31, 1918 in Brooklyn, Michigan to the late Lillian DeLong Blowers and Raymond Eli Blowers. She was a graduate of Brooklyn High School in Michigan and Trinity Bible College in Florida. She was a Pastor's wife and owned and operated Beth's Beauty Salon in Spencer, NC.

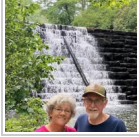
