July 30, 1924 - May 30, 2018

Betty Lloyd Chester, 93, of Salisbury, NC died Wednesday, May 30, 2018 at the Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House.

Born July 30, 1924 in Spencer, NC to the late Mary Alta Lindley Lloyd and William G. Lloyd, Sr., she was educated in Spencer schools and graduated from Spencer High School. She graduated from H.L. Long Nursing School in Statesville. Mrs. Chester was a registered nurse for 10 years at Rowan Memorial Hospital and 30 years at the VA Medical Center.

Mrs. Chester was a member of John Calvin Presbyterian Church where she was a former Sunday school teacher, served as an Elder and a member of the Prison Ministry. She volunteered with Crisis Assistance, Meals on Wheels, the Red Cross and Rowan Helping Ministries outreach program. Betty received the special Human Rights Award from the Salisbury-Rowan Church of Women United.

Preceding her in death is her husband Stanley Mark Chester on November 6, 2010; brothers, William "Bill" G. Lloyd, Jr and Samuel Lloyd; and sister, Ruth Ruble.

Surviving are her daughters, Alta Green of Salisbury, NC, Dana Marske of Clemmons, NC, and Trina Chester of Salisbury, NC; sister, Frances Wall of Tabacoville, NC; grandchildren, Mark Marske (Megan) of Denver, NC, Sarah Marske of Atlanta, GA, Daniel Green (Kathryn) of Virginia Beach, VA and Alex Green of Salisbury, NC; and great-grandchildren, Evan Marske, Lucas Marske, Sophie Cole, Silas Green and Sully Green.
