



## Ms. Betty Ruth Honeycutt Jones

September 16, 1931 - October 2, 2014

Betty Ruth Honeycutt Jones, 83 of Cleveland, NC went to her eternal resting place on Thursday October 2, 2014.

Born in Watauga County on September 16, 1931 she was the daughter of the late Robert Lee Honeycutt and Sarah Winkler Honeycutt. She was the first kindergarten teacher in the state of N.C. starting the pioneer program in Piney Creek, N.C. She also was a homemaker, raising three children.

Preceding her in death is her husband, Rev. Shirley Thomas Jones, who died February 13, 2013.

Surviving are two sons, Wayne Jones, wife Sharon of Nashville, NC; Dana Jones and wife Wendy of Raleigh; daughter, Terry Jones of Cleveland; sister, Katherine Garland of Montgomery, AL and four grandchildren, Matthew, Danielle, Rainey and Tyler.

The family will see friends Sunday at Cleveland United Methodist Church from 1-2 PM with services following at 2 PM. The Rev. Sybil Perrell, church minister will officiate. The body will lie in state from 1-2 PM Sunday. Burial will follow services at the Woodleaf United Methodist Church cemetery.
