



## Betty Livengood Lippard

August 18, 1930 - April 22, 2019

Betty Livengood Lippard, 88, of Salisbury, passed away Monday, April 22, 2019 at her home.

Born August 18, 1930 in Rowan County, she was the daughter of the late John Clarence "JC" Livengood and Purnie Copley Livengood.

Mrs. Lippard was educated in the Granite Quarry schools. She was an Office Manager for Leisure Lads and later she worked in food service at the Rowan County schools.

She was a member of Rockwell United Methodist Church, the Golden Rule Sunday School Class, served as a Sunday school teacher on all levels, was a former Church Treasurer, was a past President and member of the United Methodist Women. 
