Billie Campbell Beattie, born March 25, 1931, passed peacefully on October 2, 2024, at the age of 93. Billie lived a long, fulfilling life and was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother.

watching hummingbirds, but her greatest joy was in her relationship with her Lord and Savior, whom she loved above all else. She never missed a day she didn't write all prayer requests down in a notebook one by one as she prayed for them.

Billie will be remembered for her unwavering love for her family and friends, her faith, and her kind, gentle spirit. She will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved her. She never met anyone she didn't like and saw everyone through the eyes of Jesus.

Her final words to her daughter were, "Please tell my grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and great-great grandchildren how much I love them."
