Billy "Bill" Earl Hathcock, 74, of Salisbury, passed away Sunday, December 13, 2020 at Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center, Winston-Salem.

Born June 18, 1946 in Rock Hill, SC, he was the son of the late Fay Walker Bost Hathcock and Paul Earl Hathcock.
