Billy Ray Moore, 78, of Salisbury, died November 3 at his home. Mr. Moore was born August 2, 1933 to the late Lewis Ray Moore and Thelma Troutman Moore.

He graduated from Boyden High School of Salisbury, NC and soon after joined the United States Air Force.
