



## Bobby Lee Morris

November 8, 1938 - January 29, 2013

Mr. Bobby Lee Morris, 74, of Salisbury, NC passed away Tuesday, January 29, 2013 at Autumn Care of Salisbury.

Born November 8, 1938 in Troy, NC to the late Willie Randall Morris and Sarah Catherine Hogans Morris, he was educated in the Troy City schools and at Lexington High School. Mr. Morris worked at Erlanger Mill and at Celanese Industries where he retired after working there 27 years.
