Rev. Bobby Van Seagroves, 87, of China Grove, NC passed away Tuesday, December 28, 2021 at Atrium Health Cabarrus Hospital.

Born February 14, 1934 in Wake County, NC he was the son of the late Willie Vann Seagroves and Margaret Naomi Miller.

Rev. Seagroves attended Campbell College, where he met the love of his life, Janette.
