



Mr. Calvin L. Hendrix

November 25, 1923 - September 30, 2016

Mr. Calvin L. Hendrix, 92, of Spencer, NC passed away September 30, 2016 at his home after a brief illness.

Born November 25, 1923, in Pittsylvania County, Virginia he was the son of the late Mary Lou Farrar Hendrix and Orville Linwood Hendrix. He graduated from Gretna High School in Gretna, Virginia.

Shortly after, he married Margaret "Jean" Tribble and they moved to Spencer, NC, where he worked as a fireman with Southern Railroad for ten years. Then he was self-employed as a painting contractor until he retired. He was an active member of Central United Methodist Church, participating in the Gordon Gobbel Sunday School Class and Methodist Men. He also served as a Trustee. After retiring, he served as Alderman and Mayor Pro-tem for the Town of Spencer.
