Carl Lee Dean, 83, of Salisbury died Tuesday, February 1, 2011 at the Brian Center of Salisbury.

Born August 30, 1927 in Kernersville, he was the son of the late Bertha Holcomb Dean and O. R. Dean, Sr. He graduated from James A. Gray High School, Winston-Salem in 1945 and attended George Washington University, Washington, DC.

Mr. Dean was a veteran of the US Army's 701st Military Police Battalion serving in China and Japan.

He started his career in banking at the City National Bank, Winston-Salem and retired June 1991 as Chief Financial Officer and Senior Vice President from Security Bank and Trust after 22 years of service.

Mr. Dean was a member of Calvary Baptist Church and was a former Deacon and Sunday School teacher, and volunteered at Rowan Regional Medical Center in the Surgical Family waiting room.
