Carol Snider Cauble, 88, of Salisbury, went to be with our Lord and Saviour on Monday, February 9, 2026 at Trinity Oaks Health and Rehab Center in Salisbury, NC.

Born July 1, 1937 in Rowan County, she was the daughter of the late Paul and Mary Snider of Spencer, NC. She was a graduate of Spencer High School Class of 1955 and completed several courses at Rowan Cabarrus Community College. She was employed with the Rowan County Parks and Recreation Department from 1970 until 1985, then with the Piedmont Correctional Institution from 1995 until 2000 and retired shortly thereafter. She was a past member of Central United Methodist Church in Spencer NC, of Franklin Presbyterian Church, Salisbury, NC, where she was a member of the church choir, Sunday School and Evening Circle and of Shiloh Reformed Church of Faith where she sang in the choir.
