Carrie Kluttz Graham, 102, of Salisbury passed away Saturday, June 23, 2012 at the Lutheran Home at Trinity Oaks.

Born May 12, 1910 in Rowan County, she was the daughter of the late Arthur Lee and Roxana Park Kluttz. Her grandfather, Charles Franklin Kluttz served as a guard at the Salisbury Confederate Prison under Captain William Howard. She was educated in the Salisbury schools and for 48 years she was employed with Cone Mills, Salisbury Plant before retiring August 16, 1977.

She was a member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church and the Cone Mill, Stallings Memorial Baptist Church, and the First United Church of Christ Senior Citizens Clubs and the Harold B. Jarrett American Legion Auxiliary.

Her husband, Council M. Graham preceded her in death on August 12, 1977. Brothers, G. Dewey Kluttz, Lonnie C. L. Kluttz, Clyde F. Kluttz and Alvin C. Kluttz; sisters, Esther Kluttz Rinehart, Maggie Kluttz. Bonds also preceded her in death.

She survives by 8 nieces and two nephews.
