



## Charles F. Lamb, Sr.

July 25, 1920 - March 31, 2010

Mr. Charles Flowers Lamb, Sr., 89, of Cleveland, NC passed away on Wednesday, March 31, 2010 at his residence.

Born July 25, 1920 in Sampson County, NC to the late Mattie Mae Flowers Lamb and Leon Henry Lamb, he was a graduate of Sampson County Schools. Mr. Lamb served in the Navy during WWII. He helped with the family farm. He was a machinist at Grinnell Inc. then worked in Research and Development for American Moistening in Cleveland, NC. Later, he retired from Gamewell Mechanical as a supervisor.

Mr. Lamb was a member of Cleveland First Baptist Church. He served on the Advisory Board of the Machine Shop at Rowan Cabarrus Community College. He was a member of the Woodmen of the World.
