Charles Hilbert Glover, Jr, 78, of Salisbury passed away on Saturday, November 18, 2017 at the Lutheran Home at Trinity Oaks of Salisbury.

Charles was born on December 2, 1938 to the late Charles Hilbert and Julia Moose Glover. Charles grew up in Salisbury and was a graduate of Boyden High School and Catawba College.
