Mr. Charles Franklin McSwain, 72 of Salisbury, NC went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, Nov. 29, 2015. Charles was born on January 22, 1943 in Davie County, the son of Mildred Link McSwain and Richard James McSwain, Sr.

Charles was a graduate of Davie High School and a veteran of the US Navy during the Cuban Missile Crisis, serving from 1960 to 1966. Before retiring he had worked for the Grand Prairie Police Dept. Dallas, Texas, Mocksville Prison Unit for twenty years retiring as a Sergeant, also he had worked for Cone Mills for twenty years and the NC Dept. of Corrections High Rise Unit for seven years .

He was a member of Community Baptist Church of Mocksville and a member of the Kennedy Hall American Legion Post #106.

He was preceded in death by his father, Richard James McSwain, Sr. and a brother William Floyd McSwain.
