Charles Albert Miller, 74, of Salisbury, NC passed away Wednesday, January 20, 2021 at Novant Health Rowan Regional Medical Center.

He was born April 18, 1946 in Minneapolis, MN to the late Barbara Kruse Miller and Alfred T. Miller and graduated in 1964 from Osseo High School. Over the years, Charles worked at Blackstone, Cummins and Freightliner.

He was a member of Resurrection Life Church in Salisbury, NC and was ordained as a pastor in 2001.
