Charles Leroy Mentus, affectionately known as “Chuck” 85, of Salisbury, NC passed away Friday, December 1, 2017 at the NC State Veterans Home in Salisbury.

Born May 28, 1932 in Peabody, Massachusetts he was a son of the late John Mentus and Theresa Tkachuk Mentus. He was a veteran of the US Army serving during the Korean War. Chuck later retired from Norman’s of Salisbury.
