Clarence Colbert "C.C." Freeman, Jr., 86 of Salisbury passed away Sunday, April 1, 2018 at the Liberty Lane Hospice at the W. G. Hefner VA Medical Center.

Born February 24, 1932 in Thomasville, he was the son of the late Clarence Colbert Freeman, Sr. and Eva Mae Miller Freeman.

He was educated in the Thomasville schools, and graduated from the Pilot High School, received his BS degree from High Point University and his Doctorate in Theology from the Christian Life School of Theology.

Mr. Freeman started as a teacher at Fair Grove Elementary School, Thomasville and Denton High School where he served as Coach for Girls Basketball. He later was employed by Security Bank where he was an Insurance Manager and Salesman before retiring. After retiring he served as a substitute teacher for the Rowan/Salisbury School System.

Mr. Freeman was a veteran of the US Navy where he served on the USS Missouri.

He was a member of the River of Life Church, the Toni Iossi Sunday School Class, was a former member and Past President of the Salisbury Optimist

Club and the Salisbury Kiwanis Club.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his twin brothers Ned and Ted Freeman and other brothers DeWitt Freeman, Wayne Freeman; and a sister, Lou Willie Hunt.
