Corinne Stiller DeMarcus, 96, of Cornelius, passed away January 16, 2025 at Brighton Gardens in Charlotte.

Born September 2, 1928 in Salisbury, she was a daughter of the late John Leo Stiller and Beatrice Corinne Baity Stiller. She was a graduate of UNCG (Women's College) and earned a Master's Degree at Duke University. She taught school for over 40 years in Rowan and Forsyth County schools.

She lived most of her adult life in Winston-Salem. She was a member of First Christian Church in Winston-Salem and Beta Sigma Phi Sorority.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband of 49 years, William B. DeMarcus, Jr. on November 16, 2001.
