



## Dagny Gerda Robosky

June 3, 1920 - December 28, 2010

Dagny Robosky, 90, of Salisbury, NC, died Tuesday, December 28, 2010 at Rowan Regional Medical Center, after a fall.

Born Dagny Gerda Overgaard on June 3, 1920, she was brought up in the Danish Sisterhood and was extremely proud of her first-generation American heritage. She chose to serve her country as a “Rosie the Riveter” munitions worker in WWII, becoming the first in her family to go to college.

She was preceded in death by her husband of fifty-three years, John H. Robosky, Jr. (born in Forbes Road, PA and deceased in 1997.)

They began their forever-union on Poplar Street in Denver, CO, and later moved to Route One, Bonifay, FL where she dedicated her working life to The Bank of Bonifay on Waukaw Street. Upon early retirement, they moved to Osborn Street in Trinity, NC. Her final years were spent in Salisbury, NC with her chosen “extended family.”

Remaining to cherish her memory are her daughter, Dayna Anderson, special care-giver Delfina Serrano, and numerous nieces and nephews all over the U.S. and abroad.

A service in celebration of Dagny’s long and rich life will be held at a later

date, with her ashes scattered in her beloved Colorado Rockies.
