Daniel Joseph “Dan” Deziel, 78, of Salisbury, NC, passed away Sunday, May 17, 2026 at his residence.

Born July 1, 1947 in Houghton County, MI, Mr. Deziel was the son of the late Fabian Joseph Deziel and Alice Eloida Cote.

Mr. Deziel was a graduate of Chassell High School, class of 1965. He served in the US Army from 1965-1967, 2nd Engineer Battalion and was stationed in South Korea.
