September 3, 1940 - October 9, 2015

Mr. David "Pap" Sides, 75, of Salisbury, NC, passed away, Friday, October 9, 2015 at the W.G. Hefner VA Medical Center in Salisbury.

Mr. Sides was born September 3, 1940 in Rockwell, NC to the late James Cleveland Sides and Ethel Swinson Sides.

He was a 1958 graduate of Rockwell High School and attended Rowan Cabarrus Community College. He was a veteran of the US Army serving in Korea. David worked for Fiber Industries until his retirement. He was a member of Gloria Dei Lutheran Church and served on the church council, Assistant Boy Scout Leader of Troop 403, Assistant Boy Scout Leader of the Year in 2005, and, Vigil Honor Order of the Arrow Lodge 188. He was a member of the Andrew Jackson Masonic Lodge and Scottish Rites. He was an auxiliary officer with the Rowan County Sheriff's office.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Glenn Albert Sides.
