Deane Curry Cline, 96 of Salisbury passed away Saturday, July 21, 2018 at the Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House.

Deane was born November 6, 1921 in Asheville, NC, the daughter of Harold Delo Curry and Virginia West Curry.

Deane attended Miss Conley's School and The Rochester School of Fine Arts and Science. She later moved to Charlotte where she met and married Dr. Wayne Allen Cline.

A longtime member of the First United Methodist Church of Salisbury, Deane was a member of the altar guild and church circle. She was also an early supporter of the Rowan Museum, the Rowan Regional Medical Auxiliary and she later served on the Rowan Regional Hospital Foundation Board. Deane and her late husband also supported the Glenn Kiser Hospice House. Her many interests and support included Rowan Helping Ministries, the Rowan Regional Memorial Hospital where she was a member of the Heritage Society, the Salisbury Historic Society, and the Waterworks Guild. Deane had a lifelong interest in education and supported both Rowan Cabarrus Community College and Catawba College. She was an avid reader and a longtime member of the Lejeudi Book Club. She also enjoyed playing bridge with her friends and family.

Deane was preceded in death by her husband of 67 years, Wayne, and her brother James West Curry. She is survived by her son Dr. Wayne Allen Cline, Jr. and his wife Christy of Salisbury, her daughter Deborah Cline Isbister
