Diane Allison Coulter Baty, 58, of Woodleaf, NC passed away Wednesday, June 8, 2022 at Davie Nursing & Rehabilitation in Mocksville, NC. She had a stroke in October of 2014 which disabled her body but not her mind. Attempts at physical therapy were not successful.

Diane was born July 1, 1963 in Statesville, NC to Bette Myers Coulter of Woodleaf, NC and the late James B. Coulter, Sr. She was a granddaughter of the late Ben and Mildred Myers and the late Flake and Sarah Coulter. She excelled in studies at school graduating with honors from West Rowan High School, received a 4-year scholarship from Martin Marietta Aggregates. She earned a Bachelor of Science in nursing from UNC-Charlotte and worked as a Registered Nurse for 32 years.

Diane was a loving daughter, mother, and friend to many who will miss her dearly. She was a sports enthusiast, specifically being a Panthers and Duke fan. Diane was devoted to her children and spent a great deal of time watching Evan play ball and Emily dance in recitals. She loved reading, watching TV/movies with the kids, and traveling to the beach and distant states.
