Mr. Dickie Ronald Fraley, 68, of Cleveland, NC passed away Saturday, April 3, 2021 at Novant Health Rowan Medical Center in Salisbury.

Born April 1, 1953 in Iredell County, he was the son of the late William Horace Fraley and Margaret Pence Fraley Cook.
