



Mr. Donald Ray Leazer

June 14, 1939 - November 25, 2014

- Donald Ray Leazer, age 75, passed away on Tuesday, Nov. 25, 2014, at the Glenn A Kiser Hospice House, Salisbury, after a brief 3 month battle with cancer.

He was born June 14th, 1939 in Salisbury, the son of the late Pauline and Hubert Leazer. He served 4 years in the US Air Force, before joining the NC State Highway Patrol. After 32 years of service and retiring as a First Sergeant at the age of 51, he retired to enjoy a life of traveling in his RV with his wife.

In between traveling he volunteered for the American Red Cross, prepared taxes at H&R Block, and worked part time as a Union County Sheriff's Deputy. He was a member of the Cary Masonic Lodge #198 and Stallings Memorial Baptist Church, Salisbury.

Survivors include his wife, Betty of Salisbury; a son, Mick and wife Kristin Leazer of Olive Branch, MS and a daughter, Dona and husband Lee Walker of Salisbury; 6 grandchildren Brie, Erikka, Andrew, Mikayla, Kaden, Gavin; and his brothers Gary and Judy Leazer of Faith, Bill and Jan Leazer of Salisbury.
