Donald Thomas Lyerly, 76, of Salisbury, passed away Sunday, January 10, 2021 at his home.

Born May 24, 1944 in Rowan County, he was the son of the late Mary "Sue" Goss Lyerly and Ralph Thomas Lyerly.

Mr. Lyerly graduated from South Rowan High School, Class of 1962 and Rowan Cabarrus Community College. He was a Veteran of the U.S. Army (Rank E-4) serving from 1966-1969.

A welder/machinists by trade, he was Production Manager for Salisbury Machinery before retiring. Prior to that he was employed by Brad Ragan and Cannon Mills.

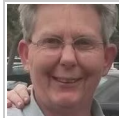
