Doris Francis Brownlee, 95, passed away Monday, September 6, 2010 at CMC-Northeast in Concord.

Born September 18, 1914, in Brookfield, Mo., she was one of eight children of the late Claud Vanis Francis and Marie Ethel Lillian Francis. She received a baccalaureate degree from Colorado State University in Fort Collins, Colo., and was a member of KAO sorority.

Mrs. Brownlee had resided in Rowan County since 1953. She was a teacher at Granite Quarry High School and Corriher Lipe Junior High. She has been an active member of the American Association of University Women, the Rowan Bird Club, Rowan County Genealogical Society, Elizabeth Maxwell Steele Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, and the First Presbyterian Church. She had received an Honorary Life Membership from the Women of the Church.

Mrs. Brownlee was preceded in death by her husband Marion Richard "Dick" Brownlee and her son Richard Francis Brownlee. She is survived by her daughter Ann Brownlee of Salisbury and numerous nieces and nephews.
