Douglas Louie, age 90, of Granite Quarry passed away Thursday, February 22, 2018 at Tucker Hospice House in Kannapolis.

Mr. Louie was born on January 29, 1928 in Hong Kong, a son of the late Fong Yee Louie and Yuet Ngan Ho. He was a graduate of St. Andrews College in Saskatoon, Canada, Rochester Divinity School in Rochester, NY, Syracuse University in Syracuse NY where he earned his MSW and PhD. Douglas was a minister of the United Church of Canada for 20 years, Rochester New York area and as a supply and interim minister in the Boston Massachusetts area. He worked as a clinical social worker for the Veterans Administration in Boston. He was an author of two books and was working on his third.

Preceding him in death was his first wife May Wong Louie whom he married in 1954 and died in 1969; son Jeffrey Louie; brother Philip Louie; sister Alice Chen; great-grandson Vance Gabriel Stephan.
