



Dr. Homer "Fritz" F. Schroeder

September 26, 1920 - December 19, 2010

Dr. Homer F. "Fritz" Schroeder, M.D., 90, of Greensboro, NC passed away Sunday, December 19, 2010 at Well Spring Care Center in Greensboro, NC.

Born September 26, 1920 in Leipsic, OH, he was the son of the late Gertrude S. and Leo C. Schroeder.

Dr. Schroeder attended DeSales College in Toledo, OH; graduated from the University of Toledo, Toledo, OH in 1943; St. Louis University School of Medicine in 1946, and from the University of Pennsylvania School of Graduate Medicine in Obstetrics and Gynecology, Philadelphia, PA, in 1950. He served in the US Naval Reserve from 1946-1958. He retired in 1989 and during his career in Toledo, Ohio he was in private practice in specializing in Obstetrics and Gynecology, served on the staff of St. Charles Hospital (Director of Department of OB/GYN 1958-1970,) St. Vincent's Hospital and Mercy Hospital (Director of Department of OB/GYN 1966-1984 and Chief of Staff, 1984-1986) and at the Medical College of Ohio at Toledo (Clinical Professor Department of OB/GYN, 1976-1989).

He was active in many Professional Societies including the Academy of Medicine of Toledo and Lucas County, Ohio State Medical Association, American Fertility Society and a founding member of the Gynecologic Laser Society.

His many interests included membership in Toastmasters' International (Director, 1977-1979,) "Society for the Preservation and Encouragement of Barbershop Quartet Singing in America" Vero Beach, FL Chapter and the Lincoln Auto Owners Club.

Dr. Schroeder is survived by his sons, Charles Schroeder and his wife Molly of City Island, NY and Eric Schroeder and his wife Vickie of Grand Haven, MI; daughters, Catherine Carter and husband Donald of Liberty, NC, Donna D'Jernes and husband Roger of Cary, NC and Lori Cencer and husband Robert of Evans Lake, MI; nine grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Janet and son Paul.

A memorial service and celebration of his life will be held at Well Springs, 4100 Well Spring Dr., Greensboro at 1:00 PM, December 23, 2010. The family will receive friends following the service.
