



## Dr. Mary Elizabeth Mayrand

October 31, 1918 - October 2, 2010

Dr. Mary Elizabeth Mayrand, 91, of Salisbury died Saturday, October 02, 2010 at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Born October 31, 1918 in Pittsburgh, PA, she was the daughter of the late Hubert Joseph Mayrand, Sr. and Katherine Conner Mayrand.

Educated in the New Rochelle, NY and Chicago schools, Dr. Mayrand graduated from Northwestern University and the University of Illinois College of Medicine. She completed her residency in Pathology at Wake Forest University Baptist Medical Center.

She began her medical career as a general practitioner in Chicago and the VA Medical Center in Salisbury. In 1968 she joined the staff of Rowan Memorial Hospital and served as Chief of Pathology for 6 years prior to her retirement in 1991.

Dr. Mayrand was a member and Past President of the Rowan County Medical Society and served as a Medical Examiner of Rowan County. She was a member of the Rowan County Wildlife Association, and was a championship skeet shooter. An avid golfer, she was a member of the Salisbury Country Club, enjoyed horseback riding and was an instrument rated pilot.

She was preceded in death by a dear friend, Ann Hubbard, a sister, Kay M. Parcell-Zelle and her brother, Hubert Joseph Mayrand, Jr.
