Mr. Earl Rayvon Curran, 87, passed away Wednesday, February 11, 2015 at the North Carolina State Veterans Home in Salisbury, NC.

Mr. Curran was married on May 10, 1945 in York, South Carolina to June Marie Wyrick and they would have celebrated their 70th wedding anniversary this year. Their love and devotion set an example for the rest of their family and anyone who knew them.

Mr. Curran was born March 13, 1927 in Rowan County, the son of the late Fleet C. Curran and Mamie Odessa Lowder Curran. He was a veteran of the United States Coast Guard, served in World War II and educated in the Rowan County Schools. Past Master of the Andrew Jackson Masonic Lodge and Past Commander of the Harold B. Jarrett American Legion Post, he served his country well. He was a former member of Christ Methodist Church, Salisbury.

He worked for Carolina Tractor and Equipment Company, first in Salisbury and then in Charlotte for 50 years serving clients well whom he considered family. He loved his work and his commitment to his profession earned him many lifelong friends.
